COVID-19 TESTING

Shawnee County residents should first call their Primary Care Provider to see if testing is available through that clinic location. Individuals experiencing **two or more symptoms of COVID-19** are eligible for testing if supplies are available. Always call ahead before entering a primary care clinic.

COVID-19 Symptoms include:

- Fever of 100.4 (F) or higher
- Chills
- Rigors
- Muscle pain or aches
- Malaise
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea

- Test results are available within 3-5 business days
- If the test is positive or negative, you will receive a phone call at the number you provided when you scheduled your appointment.
