

## Shawnee Heights High School Summer Drivers Education Program Policies and Procedures

**Student Eligibility:** Shawnee Heights High School will offer a summer driver education program for any student residing in USD #450 who is 14 years of age.

**Graduated Driver License Law:** For information on the Kansas Graduated Driver's License Requirements for Teen Drivers go to <http://www.ksrevenue.org/dmvgdl.html>

**Program Fee:** A \$202 course fee will be charged at the time of initial enrollment in the driver education class.

**Course Requirements:** Drivers Education consists of two parts. Students are required to attend 5 days of class where they complete their written course work, then they are required to drive with an instructor for 5 sessions. The two are described in more detail below:

**Written Coursework:** Students are required to attend class June 3<sup>rd</sup> thru June 7<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Students who miss more than one day of class may be unable to complete the program. Students will need to bring a sack lunch each day.

**Driving with Instructor:** Students will be required to drive for 5 sessions with an instructor. Refer to the enrollment form for session dates and times. When students are scheduled to drive they will report to school (for three hours) the same time every day for five consecutive days. Students will have an opportunity to sign up for the times and days of their choice.

**Grading Procedure:** No student will be eligible for credit unless that student completes each instructional (classroom and behind the wheel) module at the stated criteria. Students passing Driver Education will receive one fourth of elective credit on their transcript. This class will not count toward the student's grade point average because grades are based on either credit or non-credit.

**Transportation:** Students will be responsible for finding their own transportation to and from the high school for both the classroom and driving phase of the program.
